Salerno. New success for Jomi Salerno within the friendly walls of the Palumbo Corporal Gym. The reigning Italian Champions beat Cassano 32 – 21 in the match valid as the sixth day of the Beretta Serie A second leg. The race was never in question and as many as twelve players reported for the training coach Laura Avram at the end of the challenge. The best is Ramona Manojlovic, author of eight markings and thus climbed to 116 in the season. The guest team led on the bench by coach Salvatore Onelli holds the impact for the first eighteen minutes (8 – 7 signed by Gloria Montoli) then has to surrender to the higher quality of Jomi Salerno. Captain Napoletano and companions place, in fact, a break of seven goals for two, running away until 15 – 8 with which you arrive at the interval. The music doesn't change in the second half. Cobianchi tries to keep Cassano afloat, on the other side he scores Ilaria Dalla Costa (20 - 10 to 7'). Dalla Costa and captain Napoletano keep the home team forward (22-11). Laita tries to reduce the passive, but Romeo, Lauretti Matos and Manojlovic score (25-12), forcing guest coach Onelli to call the time out. Upon returning to the field Giulia Gozzi's double seems to give oxygen to the Lombards (25 - 14). On the 18th' comes Manojlovic's goals for the Salerno, Laita and Gozzi's goals for the Lombards who set the score at 26 - 16. Montoli and Ferrazzi still score for Cassano. Romeo and the young Giorgia Avagliano interrupt the good time of the visiting team (28-19). There is also room for Giulia Rossomando. Lauretti Matos brings Jomi Salerno back to +10. Mister Onelli relies on seven movement athletes, doing without the goalkeeper, but the scheme is not always effective. Cassano has one last gasp with Ferrazzi. In the fast break he scores Rossomando then the extreme defender Elisa Ferrari scores goal from goal to goal, setting the score on the final 32-21. This is how Jomi Salerno has the 13th win of the season.
