UNEATLANTICO PEREDA SAVES A DRAW IN THE FINAL STRETCH

It was a hard week for **Uneatlantico Pereda to** start since it was going to play three games. He started receiving Santa Cruz de Tenerife Handball in the Outdoor Pavilion of La Albericia. After another bad match in Lanzarote, the yellow ones were willing to change the image as they already did in the last home game. They were not at all fine in attack but in attack and finally the game ended 20-20 after a beautiful match.

The match began with some inaccuracies but soon the goals arrived. The first two goals of Santa Cruz Tenerife Handball were quickly answered by two goals from Captain Andrea Pellón. 
